

Austin student says tribe emblem an issue at school

AUSTIN, Texas — An Austin middle school student says she was sent home because of her religious clothing. But the school's principal says they embrace their diverse community. Victoria Mouse, an eighth grader at Covington Middle School in South Austin, says Thursday a school officials asked

her to take off her sweatshirt. She and her family belong to the United Keetoowah band of Cherokee Indians. The hoodie has the tribe's emblem. She wore it again Friday with a pair

of shorts with a frayed bottom. Austin Independent School District says the torn shorts and logos are against school policy and it is cracking down on dress code enforcement.

"This is a part of me. It's religious. All the other kids have crosses and it shows that Jesus died for them. Well, my ancestors died so I could be here," Victoria says.

Mouse's dad says if crosses can be worn, why not their emblem?

'Our people died on the Trail of Tears," Jess Mouse says. "If you're going to make an exception

for everybody else it's unfair. It violates her civil rights. It violates her FIRST federal rights because we're a registered federally recognized tribe."

Covington Middle School principal Candace Hughs principal issued a statement.

Covington is a diverse student community, which we fully embrace. It's wonderful, and makes us a rich, caring school. We recognize that students

may want to express religious convictions, which are allowed in a variety of ways, which include wearing jewelry and special dress days. Additionally, a student and their family may submit an article of clothing with a religious theme to the Principal's office for prior approval.

This year our teachers are helping administrators with enforcement of the campus dress code, so that there is consistency across the campus. Teachers provide dress code compliant clothing to students, as needed, in the classroom. This is so that students miss limited instructional time and there are no consequences to the student.

Consistent enforcement of the new expanded dress code has already had a positive impact on student behavior this year.

Headdress leaves for Pine Ridge By Alissa Skelton

LINCOLN, Neb. — A prized Lakota eagle feather headdress kept in Lincoln for 57 years has begun its journey back to Pine Ridge.

On Saturday, the Lakota war bonnet was presented to about 10 members of the Oglala Sioux Tribe during a repatriation ceremony in Lincoln.

The bonnet, with roughly 100 eagle feathers, was said to be older than any living member of the tribe.

The 2 p.m. ceremony was held at the William Canby Arena next to the Lincoln Indian Center, 1100 Military Road. More than 100 people came to watch the celebration, filled with dancing and tribal music.

A 1950s Nebraska Governor, North Platte native Robert Crosby, was given the headdress in 1953 at the Sheridan County Fair by Chief Fools Crow and Ben American Horse. Receiving the headdress meant Crosby was adopted as a brother to Chief Fools Crow.

Along with the eagle feather headdress, Crosby was given the Lakota name "Knife Chief." The Oglala Sioux Tribe liked Crosby because they saw him as a great community leader who stood by the tribe.


