

# Wausau attorney receives funeral honor

WAUSAU, Wis. — Wausau attorney Gene Linehan received a rare honor following his Sept. 10 death in Bayfield, where his life was celebrated at a traditional American Indian funeral ceremony typically reserved for tribal members.

Linehan, 66, represented many Indians and became friends with them during his long career. Following his death, the Bad River Chippewa tribe and members of other tribes across Wisconsin honored Linehan with a four-day funeral ceremony.

“When someone is part of a society, the native indigenous

society, and works with us as much as Gene did, he is considered a brother,” said Kenneth “Bum Bum” Fish, a Menominee and longtime friend of Linehan’s. “Gene had the spirit of an indigenous person.”

Linehan’s wife, Amy Jo Linehan, said the ceremony was important for her husband because of his love for native people and their culture.

But Gene had friends and family across the state and they, too, will have a chance to remember the attorney. A celebration of Linehan’s life will be held Sunday at the Hiawatha Restaurant and Lounge in Wausau.

Linehan’s relationship with Wisconsin’s Indian community is

long and storied. Among the hundreds of cases he took on, Linehan provided counsel in 1975 for the Menominee Warrior Society during its 34-day takeover of an abandoned property in Shawano County. In 1996, Linehan also represented the Bad River Chippewa tribe who blocked a train from transporting toxic chemicals across tribal land to mines near Lake Superior.

“He championed the underdog, he believed in the Native American culture,” Amy Jo Linehan said of her husband.

On Sept. 11, the day after Linehan’s death, a ceremonial fire was lighted and burned for four days, Fish said. That began three days of mourning and preparation for the fourth, or sendoff, day. The sendoff day is when the body is buried and the deceased leaves Earth for the spirit world, Fish said.

“It’s a day of happiness and joy,” Fish said. “(Gene) feels no pain, no sorrow.”

Linehan was buried on Madeline Island next to his son, Phillip, who was 17 when he was killed in a 1985 motorcycle crash, Amy Jo Linehan said.

## Test Your Play

1. You are declarer with the West hand at Six Spades, and North leads a trump, South following suit. How would you play the hand?

**WEST**  
♠ K Q J 10 8 5 4 2  
♥ 6 3  
♦ —  
♣ A Q 9

**EAST**  
♠ A 9 7  
♥ A K J 5 2  
♦ Q 7  
♣ 6 5 2

2. You are declarer with the West hand at Six Clubs, and North leads the king of hearts. How would you play the hand?

**WEST**  
♠ K 8 4  
♥ —  
♦ J 10 6  
♣ A Q 7 6 5 4 2

**EAST**  
♠ A Q 9  
♥ Q 10 6 3 2  
♦ A Q 5  
♣ 10 3

1. This is one of those cases where you’re sure to make the contract by playing your cards correctly. Win the trump lead in dummy, ruff a diamond, play a heart to dummy’s king and ruff the queen of diamonds. Then lead a heart to the ace and return a club from dummy.

If South follows low, finesse the nine. North probably wins with the ten or jack, but whatever he returns, you are sure to make the slam. If he returns a club, or gives you a ruff-and-discard by leading a diamond, you have the rest of the tricks. Also, North cannot return a heart (if he has

one at this point) without establishing at least one of dummy’s hearts as a trick.

Finally, if South produces the club ten or jack on your club lead from dummy at trick six, you cover with the queen to create the same ending.

2. Ruff the heart and lead a low diamond to dummy’s queen. If the finesse loses to South’s king, your only chance for the slam is to find South with the doubleton king of clubs. You take a trump finesse as soon as possible and hope for the best.

If the diamond finesse at trick two wins, indicating that North has the king, lead a low trump to your ace at trick three! If the jack or king of trumps appears on this trick, you’re sure to make the slam, since your only possible loser would be a trump trick. If both defenders play low on the ace of clubs, return to dummy with a spade and lead the ten of clubs. If South follows suit, you’re home safe and sound.

Note that once the diamond finesse wins at trick two, it becomes better to play a trump to your ace than to try a trump finesse, since this guards against the singleton king in the North hand. With a slam at stake, the safety play of the ace gives you the maximum chance for the contract.
