

Quechan Tribe responds to health scare **KSWT-TV**

ARIZONA — New information about a story KSWT News 13 broke, Monday, on the possible exposure of deadly diseases to patients at the Ft. Yuma Hospital. On Thursday afternoon News 13 obtained a press release sent out by the Quechan Tribal Council.

It states:

"The Quechan Tribal Council has declared a breach of trust against the United States Indian Health Services. The Council is very concerned with the effect of this incident on the tribal community, but cautions that at this time no test results have been reported. Last week the Tribal Council sent a letter to the Director of Indian Health Service in Washington D.C. demanding that all persons who may have been placed at risk be given the option of being tested by an independent medical facility at IHS's expense. Until testing is completed, the Tribe and the community will not know the extent of harm, if any, that may have been caused by IHS unsafe practices.

"The Tribes's letter also demanded that a full, independent investigation be conducted of the entire IHS facility at Fort Yuma to determine if other clinics within the facility may have also been affected, including the dental clinic

"The Tribal Council is outraged that it took IHS over 15 months to notify the Tribe and the community of this potentially serious event. This is but another example in a long line of complaints and concerns regarding the substandard medical facilities and staff at the Fort Yuma Service Unit over the last 20 or more years. The Council has called for termination of any staff, including administration staff, that are responsible for this most recent occurrence. Under federal law, IHS has assumed a trust responsibility to provide competent and safe health care to Native Americans. That trust has been breached time and time again at Fort Yuma and throughout Indian Country. This is another example of broken promises of the United States Government. "The Tribal Council is taking a number of steps to insure IHS is held fully accountable for it's negligence. This event has caused emotional distress and harm that it has caused to the Tribal Community at Fort Yuma. The Council has instructed our tribal attorneys to bring suit against the United States and Indian Health Services to make sure that the problems that have plagued the Fort Yuma Unit for years are corrected so that the Government's promise of competent and safe health care to the our members is honored. "The Tribal Council is prepared to provide testing for HIV, Hepatitis C for the members of the tribe at large.


