

Seneca offer to pay casino communities 'unacceptable'

BUFFALO — An offer by the Seneca Nation of Indians to make casino revenue payments directly to the three local cities that host the nation's casinos is "unacceptable" to Gov. David A. Paterson.

Paterson, speaking to reporters in Niagara Square this afternoon, rebuffed a statement made by tribal leaders Friday in which they said they are willing to pay the local share of slot machine revenues directly to Niagara Falls, Salamanca and Buffalo.

Paterson said the Senecas owe more than \$200 million to the state in different types of fees.

"I understand they made a promise to pay the local governments themselves; that's unacceptable to us," Paterson said. "It's not how government works in the State of New York.'

The Seneca Tribal Council voted last month to stop making payments to the state under the nation's gaming compact. Seneca leaders have claimed the state has violated the agreement, which gives Senecas exclusive rights to operate Las Vegas-style casinos in Western New York.

Woman gets 30 months for assault

MARQUETTE, MI. — Theresa Marie Finfrock, 31, of Sault Ste. Marie, Michigan, a member of the Sault Ste. Marie Tribe of Chippewa Indians, was sentenced to 30 months in federal prison for assault resulting in substantial bodily injury, U.S. Attorney Donald A. Davis announced today.

In addition to the prison term, Senior U.S. District Judge R. Allan Edgar ordered Finfrock to serve two years of supervised release following her release from prison and to pay a \$100 special assessment.

Finfrock pled guilty to the charge on June 1, 2010.

During her plea, Finfrock admitted to assaulting her severely handicapped seven-year-old son at her residence located on land held in trust by the U.S. for the use of the Sault Ste. Marie Tribe of Chippewa Indians in January, 2005.

This assault resulted in substantial brain injuries which ultimately led to her son's death.

U.S. Attorney Davis commended the Sault Ste. Marie Tribal Police and agents of the Federal Bureau of Investigation for their work in this case.

Former Habitat for Humanity official admits molesting children

CHEYENNE— A wellknown Dewey County rancher and member of the Cheyenne River Sioux Tribe has pleaded guilty to two counts of sexual contact with

a child. Jerry Farlee, 58, of Eagle Butte entered his guilty pleas in United States District Court in Pierre on Tuesday.

Farlee admitted having sexual contact with children under the age of 12. The assaults involve three girls on different occasions from 1993 to 2006.

Farlee is the former executive director of the Eagle Butte affiliate of Habitat for Humanity. He has remained free, but confined to his ranch since shortly after his

arrest last March. Farlee was jailed Tuesday while he awaits sentencing in January. He faces up to 20

years in prison.

"If they would like us to front the money for them, and tell us that they will refund us in the next few weeks, we would consider doing that," Paterson said. "But right now, we're in court because we don't believe that they should have licenses if they're not going to pay the mandated fees."
