Residents agree with verdict in Wong trial

CHEROKEE, Okla. - Scott Welch watched the verdict live Thursday in the trial of Edwardo "Eddie" Wong

Like most on the Cherokee Indian Reservation, he wasn't surprised the jury found Wong guilty of firstdegree murder in the 2008 slaying of state Trooper David Shawn Blanton Jr

Blanton was the first member of the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians to become a trooper with the N.C. Highway Patrol. Hundreds turned out for his funeral.

'Us older guys don't have many heroes that are younger than us," Welch said. "He got killed doing his job. He is a hero.

Principal Chief Michell Hicks, the top elected leader of the Eastern Band, said the verdict was another step in seeking justice for the Blanton family.

Our tribe has lost an honorable young man who devoted his life to serving the public," he

"I believe the verdict today is one more step toward healing the broken hearts his loss has created. I, and many in our community, continue to remember Trooper Blanton's family during these difficult days, and we stand in support of them as this case enters the sentencing phase."

Wong could face the death penalty. The same jury that convicted him of murder will hear arguments for his execution and for sparing his life starting today.

Jean Sneed wasn't afraid to share her thoughts on what she would do if she were on the jury.

"He deserves the death penalty over and over again," she said. Sneed said she's

related to Blanton's mother's family. She also wasn't surprised at the verdict.

The surprise would have been if the jury had voted for seconddegree murder instead,

Sneed said. "There probably would have been a riot," she said.

Keith Derreberry, who lives in Bryson City and works in Cherokee, has followed the trial in the news.

He said the verdict was the right call. "You kill a trooper,

and you are going to get it," he said.

Welch, who was spending Thursday evening at a hot rod cruise-in with his friends, said he's thought about the death penalty in this case.

He's not sure that is the best punishment.

"Life in prison is more of a punishment," he said. "Let him sit in there, and let it gnaw at him for 50 years.'
