## Tribe signs memo with officials

FARMINGTON — The Navajo Nation is scheduled to sign a government-to-government agreement Wednesday with city officials in Farmington, where three white men are accused of branding a swastika on the

arm of a mentally disabled Navajo man.

Tribal officials say the ceremony for the long-awaited initiative will cement the New Mexico city's commitment to address human rights issues.

Navajo leaders have worked in recent years to address concerns about discrimination in communities border-

ing the sprawling reservation, which covers parts of Arizona, New Mexico and Utah.

The ceremonial signing comes right after a decision by federal prosecutors last week to pursue hate-crimes charges against three Farmington men accused of assaulting the Navajo man last spring.
