Foreign aid arrives to help Israel fight country's worst fire

HAIFA, Israel (AP) — European aircraft dumped tons of water over flames shooting from tall trees Friday in northern Israel as firefighters struggled for a second day to contain the country's worst-ever forest fire, which has killed 41 people and displaced thou-

trees were left smoldering and smoke billowed toward the Mediterranean coastline, with bits of ash flying through the air and large red flames closing in on a hotel and a spa south of

"The size of the fire is huge, the wind is very strong and there is a problem accessing the mountains and valleys, said Yoram Levi, a spokesman for Israel's fire and rescue service. "We don't have big aircraft that can carry a large amount of water. It is not enough for a large-scale fire."

The shortfall prompted an unprecedented wave of international assistance. The Jewish state is better known for sending its own rescue teams and medical personnel to other countries to help in their disaster-relief efforts.

Some 100 firefighters from Bulgaria arrived as well as fire extinguishing planes and crews from Greece and Britain, Israeli officials said. More aid was on its way from the United States, Russia, Egypt, Cyprus, Jordan, Spain, Azerbaijan, Romania and Turkey — which put aside tensions over Israel's deadly raid on a Turkish Gazabound flotilla in May to lend a hand.

Foreign Minister Avigdor Lieberman told Israel Radio that all international aid was expected to arrive by Friday afternoon and he expressed hope the fire could be suppressed by Saturday night.

Defense Minister Ehud Barak ordered the military to make all its resources available for the effort, which was being coordinated by the Israeli air force. The military said it sent soldiers and equipment, includ-

ing helicopters, bulldozers, medics and army units.

The Israeli Cabinet convened an emergency meeting to discuss the fire. Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu thanked countries around the world for their help - and made a special point to thank Turkey — before departing north to visit the wounded in hospitals and inspect firsthand the efforts to put out the fire.

"We are amid a disaster of international proportions," he said. "We have to admit that our firefighting services cannot handle a forest fire backed by such a strong wind. We don't have the means for it."

The disaster exposed critical shortfalls in emergency services. With the country's resources focused primarily on its military and police forces, firefighters have been undermanned and underfunded for years.

Levi said the country only has 1,400 firefighters, far below the worldwide average. The force also complains of

Aluf Benn, a columnist for the Haaretz daily, said the country's inability to control the flames proved it was not ready for a massive attack against it from the likes of Iran. He compared the fire to the fiasco of 1973, when Israel was caught off guard by a surprise military attack from Egypt and Syria.

Maariv columnist Ben Caspit noted that a country that carries out chilling military operations, leads the world in high-tech and whose powerful economy emerged unscathed from the global crisis, is also the country "whose fire-trucks date back to the previous century, and a country that therefore finds itself caught, standing before the flames, with its pants down."

Timorries: Salaman to a gredicalidad Key Live Sessioner

Coast's first presidential elec-

tion in a decade remained in serious doubt Friday, with the constitutional council saying it would release its own results after the electoral commission declared the opposition leader the winner.

Supporters of the incumbent President Laurent Gbagbo called Thursday's announcement that he had lost an "attempted coup." The West African nation's borders were closed Friday, and foreign TV and radio broadcasts were banned indefinitely.

The vote was meant to restore stability after a civil war in 2002-2003 that split the world's top cocoa producer in two, but tensions on Friday were on a knife edge. The United States urged the parties to accept the election commission's results showing opposition leader Alassane Ouattara

"Credible, accredited electoral observers have characterized the balloting as free and fair, and no party should be allowed to obstruct further the

process," U.S. electoral National Security Council spokesman Mike Hammer said in a statement.

Outcome of Ivory Coast vote disputed

Gbagbo's five-year mandate officially expired in 2005, but he stayed in office while claiming elections were impossible because of the war.

Election commission chief Bakayoko Youssouf announced Thursday that Ouattara had won with 54.1 percent of the vote, compared to 45.9 percent for Gbagbo after days of backroom wrangling during which the ruling party had physically prevented other commission members from announcing the outcome

of the vote. In a press conference immediately after the announcement of his victory, Ouattara called on his opponent to respect the outcome.

"I remind my brother Laurent Gbagbo of our mutual engagement to respect the results proclaimed by the independent electoral commission," he said. "I'm proud of my country which has resolutely chosen democracy today and I hope this leads to a durable peace in Ivory Coast."

Those results though must be validated by the country's constitutional council, which is led by ruling party loyalist Paul Yao N'Dre. N'Dre said on state-controlled television the electoral body's results are invalid because the commission missed a constitutionally mandated midnight deadline on Wednesday.

"Only the constitutional council is qualified to give the results of this election," he said in the broadcast. "There are some foreign TV channels amusing themselves giving results. Ivorians should consider these results null and void.'

Shortly thereafter, two decrees read on state TV announced that the country's air, land and maritime borders had been closed and that all foreign radio and TV broadcasts were banned indefinitely. A spokesman for French channel TV5MONDE issued a statement saying their programs were no longer being broadcast due to the ban.

The crackdown appeared to extend to local media.




