Gov. Arnold Schwarzenegger signed AB1325 into law earlier this month.

"This was a huge collaboration among the tribes," Morillo said in the press release.

The bill had been discussed at bimonthly meetings of an Indian child welfare statewide working group for quite some time, said Nancy Currie, Soboba director of social services, by phone. Soboba leaders asked Assemblyman Paul Cook, R-Yucca Valley, if he would author the bill and he did, she said.

More than 50 tribes helped by writing letters and testifying on behalf of the bill, she said. The bill takes effect in July 2010.
